

The following verification is needed when applying for Medicaid. If you are married, you must provide the verification for both you and your spouse:

PERSONAL RECORDS:

- Driver License (even if expired) or Michigan Non-drivers ID or birth certificate
- Social Security Card
- Medicare Card
- Any other health insurance card and proof of premium
- Proof of Immigration/alien Status
- Power of Attorney, Conservator or Guardianship papers
- Drivers License of person Applying on your behalf

ASSET RECORDS:

- Bank statements and/or credit union account statements for checking, savings, certificate of deposit, etc. for the last 6 months
- Proof of any accounts closed, transfers or property given away or sold in the last 36 months
- Trust Funds
- Titles to any cars, trucks, boats, Motorcycles, trailers, etc. that you are buying
- Proof of value of all titled vehicles Except the vehicle of highest value
- Pending lawsuits current status
- Property tax statements of any real estate that you own or hold a life lease
- Proof of loan and monthly payment for any real estate
- Record of any land contracts
- A copy of all life insurance policies as well as cash surrender value
- Proof of value of any stocks, bonds or notes payable to you

- Endowment or annuity policies
- Proof of prepaid burial
- Deed of cemetery lot
- Deed to house
- Other

INCOME RECORDS:

- Social Security/Supplemental Security Income
- Pension
- Veterans Benefits
- Income from rent or boarders
- Income from employment
- Records of self-employment
- Farm Income
- Worker's compensation
- Income from long-term care insurance policy
- Alimony or child support
- Other

HOUSEHOLD EXPENSES:

- Proof of rent/mortgage payment
- Water/sewage
- Trash pickup
- Electric
- Heat
- Telephone
- Homeowner's insurance premium
- Guardianship or conservatorship expenses
- Unpaid medical expenses (last three months)
- Personal emergency response system
- Prescription drug costs
- Proof of health insurance premium
- Other
